



Know Your Health Care FSA Eligible and Ineligible Expenses

Maximize the Value of Your Reimbursement Account - Your Health Care Flexible Spending Account (FSA) dollars can be used for a variety of out-of-pocket health care expenses. The following tables are provided to help you better understand the types of expenses that are eligible and ineligible for reimbursement by your employer's Health FSA. You, your spouse and your legal dependents eligible expenses must be incurred (not necessarily paid) in the current plan year. Expenses you pay in the current plan year that were incurred in a previous plan year are not eligible expenses.

The IRS does NOT consider the following expenses to be medical expenses that may be reimbursed under a Health Care FSA.

Ineligible Expenses

- Contact Lens and Eyeglass Insurance
- Cosmetic Surgery/Procedures
- Cosmetic & beauty aids
- Electrolysis

- Insurance Premiums
- Long Term Care Services or Premiums
- Marriage or Career Counseling
- Toothpaste & toothbrushes
- Personal Trainers
- Sunscreen (SPF less than 30)
- Swimming Lessons
- Vitamins, supplements & herbs

Note: This list is not meant to be all-inclusive.

<u>Please Note:</u> Over-the-Counter (OTC) medicines or drugs may be purchased with Health Care FSA funds so long as they are being purchased to treat, prevent or mitigate a specific medical condition for a covered individual during the current Plan Year.

Eligible Over-the-Counter Medicines and Drugs (if purchased for use by a covered individual during the current Plan Year)

- Acid controllers
- Acne medications
- Allergy & sinus medications
- Antibiotic products
- Antifungal (Foot) medications
- Antiparasitic treatments
- Antiseptics & wound cleansers
- Anti-diarrheals
- Anti-gas medications
- Anti-itch & insect bite treatments
- Baby rash ointments & creams
- Baby teething pain treatments
- Cold sore remedies
- Contraceptives

- Cough, cold & flu medications
- Denture pain relief treatments
- Digestive aids
- Ear care treatments
- Eye care medications
- Feminine antifungal & anti-itch treatment
- Fiber laxatives (bulk forming)
- First aid burn remedies
- Foot care treatments
- Hemorrhoid medications
- Homeopathic remedies
- Incontinence protection & treatment products

- Laxatives (non-fiber)
- Medicated nasal sprays, drops, & inhalers
- Medicated respiratory treatments & vapor products
- Motion sickness medicines
- Oral remedies or treatments
- Pain relief (includes aspirin)
- Skin treatments
- Sleep aids & sedatives
- Smoking deterrents
- Stomach remedies
- Unmedicated vapor products

Many OTC items that are not medicines or drugs are eligible for purchase with FSAs.

Eligible Over-the-Counter Items (Product categories are listed in bold face; common examples are listed in regular face.)

- Baby Electrolytes and Dehydration Pedialyte, Enfalyte
- Contraceptives
 - Unmedicated condoms
- Denture Adhesives, Repair, and Cleansers

PoliGrip, Benzodent, Plate Weld, Efferdent

- Diabetes Testing and Aids
 - Ascencia, One Touch, Diabetic Tussin, insulin syringes; glucose products
- Diagnostic Products

Thermometers, blood pressure monitors, cholesterol testing

Ear Care

Unmedicated ear drops, syringes, ear wax removal

Elastics/Athletic Treatments

ACE, Futuro, elastic bandages, braces, hot/cold therapy, orthopedic supports, rib belts

Eye Care

Contact lens care

Family Planning

Pregnancy and ovulation kits

Feminine Hygiene Products

tampons, pads, liners, cups, sponges

First Aid Dressings and Supplies

Band Aid, 3M Nexcare, non-sport tapes

Foot Care Treatment

Unmedicated corn and callus treatments (e.g., callus cushions), devices, therapeutic insoles

Glucosamine &/or Chondroitin

Osteo-Bi-Flex, Cosamin DS, Flex-a-min Nutritional Supplements

Hearing Aid/Medical Batteries

Home Health Care (limited segments)

Ostomy, walking aids, decubitis/pressure relief, enteral/parenteral feeding supplies, patient lifting aids, orthopedic braces/supports, splints & casts, hydrocollators, nebulizers, electrotherapy products, catheters, unmedicated wound care, wheel chairs
